Pulliam Journalism Scholarship Deadline: Nov. 15	By invitation only. GPA 3.0+. Essay required.	One full tuition scholarship
Academic Scholarships Priority Deadline: Dec. 1	Scholarship amounts are based on GPA.	Up to \$21,000
Fine Arts (Audition/Portfolio) Deadline: April 1	Students interested in music, art or theatre. Audition or portfolio required.	\$500 - \$1,000
Alumni	Students with a sibling, parent or grandparent that graduated from Franklin College.	\$500 - \$2,000
