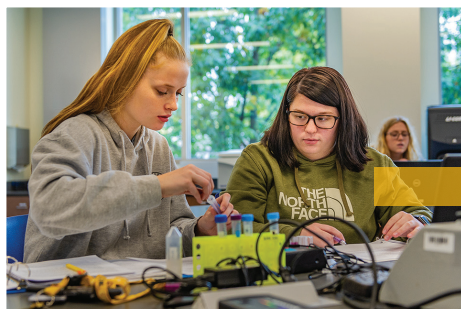




## PRE-PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS

### RISE TO THE NEXT LEVEL

#### Pre-professional tracks for countless careers

Students who begin a bachelor's program in anticipation of a career that requires an advanced degree are advised to alert their academic adviser to a pre-professional program of interest. These supplemental programs are structured so that students take all graduate school-required courses before they begin applying to programs. Franklin College's pre-professional programs include:

- **Pre-athletic training:** This program prepares students for graduate studies in athletic training, including the Franklin College Master of Science in Athletic Training program. Franklin College offers an accelerated 3+2 program, allowing students to complete both a bachelor's and a master's degree in five years.
- **Pre-dental:** This program is based on the requirements of leading dentistry schools and prepares students to take the Dental Aptitude Test (DAT). Students typically add the pre-dental track to a biology or chemistry major.
- **Pre-forensic science:** Dedicated advisers and experts in molecular biology, analytical chemistry, and criminal justice guide students through a set of courses and experiences that prepare them for a master's program in forensic science and a career in this growing field.
- **Pre-law:** This program empowers students of any major to prepare to apply for law school. Pre-law students benefit from extracurricular experiences like Mock Trial Team to engage in practice before applying to programs and taking the Law School Admission Test (LSAT).

## **EACH PROGRAM IS OVERSEEN BY A FACULTY MEMBER AND EXPERT IN THE FIELD WHO STAYS UP TO DATE ON PLACEMENT TESTS AND GRADUATE SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS.**

- **Pre-medical:** This program is based on the requirements for most U.S. medical schools and spans biology, chemistry, physics and social sciences. It prepares students to take the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) and undergo the medical school application process.
- **Pre-medical lab science:** The College operates in partnership with IU Health to offer students a unique 3+1 program. Students pursuing this track complete three years of instruction at Franklin College and one year of professional coursework with IU Health. Graduates receive a bachelor's degree from Franklin College and a licensure through IU Health.
- **Pre-occupational therapy:** This program prepares students for acceptance into an occupational therapy graduate program and ensures students have taken all foundational and required courses before applying.
- **Pre-optometry:** This program is based on pre-professional requirements for admission to the Indiana University School of Optometry and prepares students for the Optometry Admission Test (OAT).
- **Pre-pharmacy:** This program prepares students to pursue a Doctor of Pharmacy Degree (PharmD). Students can choose to complete a bachelor's program or three years of pre-pharmacy study before applying to a Doctor of Pharmacy program.
- **Pre-physical therapy:** This program prepares students to take the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) and pursue a graduate degree in physical therapy. Students on this track typically major in either exercise science or biology, though no specific major is required for acceptance into most programs.
- **Pre-physician assistant:** This program prepares students to apply for physician assistant programs, including the Franklin College Master of Science in Physician Assistant Studies.
- **Pre-podiatry:** This program prepares students to successfully complete the MCAT and apply for Doctor of Podiatric Medicine programs.
- **Pre-veterinary medicine:** This program prepares students to apply to the Veterinary Medical College Application Service (VMCAS), an organization that facilitates the application process for students seeking entrance into veterinary school.

#### **Internships and clinical experiences**

Every student who participates in a pre-professional program completes an internship, gaining practical and often clinical experience in their field of interest. Past students have interned with:

Pre-professional students have also participated in opportunities that equip them with real-world experience, including working in a medical clinic operating room in Ghana and shadowing a field veterinarian in Belize.

## **PRE-PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS OVERVIEW**

- **Medical school acceptance rate:** Franklin College's 35-year medical school acceptance rate is 85% – more than twice the national average.
- **Veterinary school acceptance rate:** Franklin College's vet school acceptance rate for the past 10 years is 90%.
- **Medical lab science:** Students who have completed this program have had a 100% employment rate over the last 5 years.
