As a 21st Century Scholar, you have many options across the state for an affordable education. Franklin College provides a supportive environment to meet your needs—helping you graduate on time and enter a meaningful career. Our program serves 21st Century Scholars financially, while connecting you with opportunities to pursue your unique passions and professional goals.

OUR PROMISE TO YOU

Through a combination of federal grants and loans, state and institutional grants and scholarships, as well as any external scholarships, Franklin College will ensure an annual direct cost of no more than \$2,100 for all 21st Century Scholars who qualify. To qualify, a 21st Century Scholar must achieve a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and be eligible for the Federal Pell Grant (see additional eligibility requirements to the right).

For those eligible students who accept their Federal Direct Loans in full, this Franklin College program for 21st Century Scholars pays toward a student's direct costs which include tuition, housing and food at Franklin College. It does not include fees, books or other indirect costs. See your admissions counselor for more details.

MORE THAN JUST FINANCIAL SUPPORT

As a 21st Century Scholar at Franklin College, you can expect more than just a full tuition guarantee. You will participate in Launch—a comprehensive first-year experience program that propels your transition into college and is completely tailored to YOU. By participating in First-Year Seminar, Launch Lab and Immersive Term, you will empower your social, personal and academic growth. You will also have the support of your Launch Team, a hand-selected group of people, including your academic adviser, first-year seminar instructor and peer mentor, who are all dedicated to helping you succeed at Franklin College.

Staff members in the Center for Student Success, located in HamiltonOne on the first floor of the library, will help you navigate the 21st Century Scholars requirements and connect you to opportunities to explore and thrive at Franklin.

APPLICATION AND ELIGIBILITY

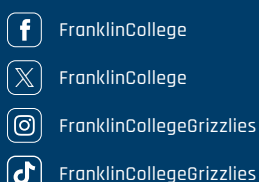
1. Submit a complete application, including high school transcript and optional test scores, to Franklin College by December 1. You can apply at FranklinCollege.edu or commonapp.org.
2. Meet the Indiana eligibility requirements for a 21st Century Scholar. See details at scholars.in.gov.
3. Complete the FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid at studentaid.gov by April 15. Institutional Code: 001798
4. Must be Federal Pell Grant eligible.
5. Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete at least 30 credit hours each year.
2. File the FAFSA each year by April 15.
3. Maintain Indiana residency.
4. Must be Federal Pell Grant eligible.
5. Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) academic standards for financial aid.

SOLICITUD Y ELEGIBILIDAD

1. Entregar una solicitud de admisión completa, junto con tu expediente académico de la escuela secundaria, y los resultados de los exámenes SAT o ACT (opcional) antes del 1 de diciembre. Puedes solicitar admisión en FranklinCollege.edu o en commonapp.org.
2. Cumplir con los requisitos de elegibilidad para el programa 21st Century Scholars del estado de Indiana. Para más detalles visita scholars.in.gov.
3. Llenar la solicitud gratuita FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) en la página studentaid.gov antes del 15 de abril. Código institucional: 001798
4. Ser elegible para la Federal Pell Grant.
5. Tener un promedio mínimo de preparatoria de 3.0 (de un total de 4.0.)

REQUISITOS DE RENOVACIÓN

1. Completar al menos 30 horas de crédito cada año.
2. Completar la solicitud FAFSA cada año antes del 15 de abril.
3. Mantener la residencia en Indiana.
4. Ser elegible para la Federal Pell Grant.
5. Mantener los estándares académicos de Satisfactory Academic Progress, para recibir ayuda financiera.
